

Holy Week: Order of Events

Sunday – Palm Sunday

Jesus' entry into Jerusalem.

Monday

Jesus flips tables over in the temple courtyard, upset about corruption occurring.

Tuesday

Jesus' authority is challenged in the temple.

Jesus teaches with stories and confronts the Jewish leaders.

Wednesday

Judas agrees to betray Jesus.

Thursday – Maundy Thursday

Jesus washes the disciples' feet.

Jesus eats the last supper with his disciples.

Friday – Good Friday

Jesus is put on trial before Pontius Pilate.

Jesus is crucified.

Saturday

Jesus' body is laid in the tomb.

Sunday – Easter Sunday

Jesus walks out of the tomb.

➤ Obey him...when it makes sense and when it doesn't

Luke 19:29-31

29 As he approached Bethphage and Bethany at the hill called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples, saying to them, 30 "Go to the village ahead of you, and as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. 31 If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' tell him, 'The Lord needs it.'"

"In the midst of this excited crowd an unbroken young animal remains completely calm, why? Because he's under the hands of the one who calms the sea. Thus, the event points to the peace of the consummated kingdom when the wolf will live with the lamb and the leopard will lie down with the goat and a little child shall lead them...for the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea." – Dr. D.A. Carson (New Testament professor)

Things become what they're meant to be in His hands.

➤ Worship him...in every season of life

Luke 19:35-38

35 They brought it to Jesus, threw their cloaks on the colt and put Jesus on it. 36 As he went along, people spread their cloaks on the road. 37 When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen: 38 "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"



Romans 1:21-23 (The Message)

People knew God perfectly well, but when they didn't treat him like God, refusing to worship him, they trivialized themselves into silliness and confusion so that there was neither sense nor direction left in their lives. They pretended to know it all, but were illiterate regarding life. They traded the glory of God who holds the whole world in his hands for cheap figurines you can buy at any roadside stand.

Luke 19:39-40

39 Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!"

40 "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."
